The GrowHealth project, funded through INTERREG programme and administered by SEEDA, aims to establish a collaborative and international network of health technology clusters to develop further the knowledge-based economy. The GrowHealth partnership is between SEHTA in the UK and the Emilia-Romagna region and Aster in Italy.

A substantial part of the project is dedicated to the production of new cluster maps for both regions highlighting the biotechnology, medical device, diagnostics and pharmaceutical companies alongside the centres of excellence and the research base in hospitals. The cluster mapping is lead by experts from the School of Management at the University of Surrey, and incorporates leading methodologies in the field.
